

PART ONE (1) OFFENSE REPORTING

Directive: 15-100

Date of Issue: July 2013 Amends/Cancels: 14-118

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Directive is to provide reporting requirements and to establish authority regarding Part (1) One Offences committed on DGS-MCP secured property.

II. POLICY

It is the policy of DGS-MCP to document all incidents of Part (1) One Offenses occurring on DGS-MCP secured property.

III. DEFINITION

Part (1) One Offenses

- a. Murder
- b. Rape
- c. Arson
- d. Robbery
- e. Larceny
- f. Aggravated Assault
- g. Breaking and Entering
- h. Motor Vehicle Theft

IV. PROCEDURES

A. Responsibilities

1. PCO

- a. Dispatch DGS-MCP officer
- b. Notify Shift Commander
- c. Notify appropriate allied law enforcement if applicable
- d. Notify Fire Department/EMS if applicable
- e. Generate CAD/RMS report number
- f. Manage incident to conclusion

2. Police Officers

- a. If on view notify PCO
- b. If dispatched by PCO respond appropriately
- c. Notify Shift Commander
- d. Request back up units if applicable
- e. Request allied law enforcement if applicable
- f. Request Fire Department/EMS if applicable
- g. Render medical assistance if applicable
- h. Secure crime scene
- i. Gather information for preliminary investigation
 - (1) Interview victim if possible
 - (2) Interview witnesses if applicable
 - (3) Gather any evidence
- j. Manage incident to conclusion
- k. Generate appropriate CAD/RMS report prior to leaving for the day
- 1. Notify Supervisor upon completion of report

3. Shift Commander

- a. Notify Detachment Commander or designee
- b. Respond to scene
- c. Assign report to officer if not pre-determined
- d. Ensure allied law enforcement has been notified if applicable
- e. Ensure Fire Department/EMS has been notified if applicable
- f. Manage incident to conclusion
- g. Ensure CAD/RMS report has been completed prior to relieving reporting officer of his/her duties
- h. Review, correct, and forward report for final approval
- i. Recommend course of action for additional follow-ups or investigations

4. Detachment Commander

- a. Notify Chief of Police or his/her designee
- b. Notify appropriate facility Superintendent
- c. Notify appropriate Fire and Safety Officer if applicable
- d. Review and approve final report
- e. Ensure follow ups investigation have been completed at patrol level
- f. If incident requires a common investigation assigned to CID

B. Allied Law Enforcement

- 1. Most Part (1) One Offenses will be reported by and investigated by the primary law enforcement agency within the jurisdiction of the offense.
- 2. Upon the conclusion of the incident it is imperative both DGS-MCP and the allied agency have a clear understanding of the delegation of authority, reporting responsibilities, and investigation responsibilities.

C. Daily Briefing

1. All Part (1) One Offenses committed on DGS-MCP secured property will appear on the first appropriate Daily Briefing.

D. Uniform Crime Reporting

- 1. All CAD/RMS reports will be generated and approved as expediently as possible to ensure inclusion in the appropriate Detachment monthly Uniform Crime Report.
- 2. It is imperative DGS-MCP and allied law enforcement are clear on the reporting of and investigation of all Part (1) One Offenses occurring on DGS-MCP secured property to prevent duplicate reporting to U.C.R.
