

LOST OR STOLEN REGULATED FIREARM

Directive: 15-115

Date of Issue: October 2014 Amends/Cancels: 14-130

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this directive is to provide policy and procedure in regards to the notification process surrounding a lost or stolen regulated firearm.

II. POLICY

All members of DGS-MCP will strictly adhere to the policy and procedures set forth in this Directive.

IV. PROCEDURES

- A. Upon receipt of a report for a lost or stolen regulated firearm, DGS-MCP will enter into the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) database, to the extent known, the caliber, make, model, manufacturer, and serial number of the regulated firearm and any other distinguishing number or identification mark on the regulated firearm.
- **B.** Upon receipt of a report for a lost or stolen regulated firearm DGS-MCP will notify the Maryland Gun Control Center by calling (855) 677-6486 or by email at <u>gun.center@maryland.gov</u> and to the extent known provide the caliber, make, model, manufacturer, and serial number of the regulated firearm and any other distinguishing number or identification mark on the regulated firearm.
